This cause came before the Court upon the petition of the Fairfield County Department of Job and Family Services for an order authorizing the provision of protective services, to the above named adult The Court has has not waived the requirement that the adult in question be personally served notice of this hearing. If the court has not waived the requirement then the adult in question was served with notice at least 24 hours prior to this hearing and did did not appear with without counsel and all necessary persons were also given or waived notice.
Based on the evidence presented, the Court finds by clear and convincing evidence that an emergency exists; the adult has been abused, neglected, or exploited and is in need of protective services; is incapacitated; and that no person authorized by law or court order is available to give consent. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
The petitioner shall be authorized to provide, or make arrangements for the following protective services for the adult:
 The Court shall authorize the Director of the Fairfield County Job and Family Services, or a designee, to give consent for the person for the approved emergency services until the expiration of the order.
 This order shall be effective immediately and for 14 days hence unless terminated or extended according to law.
