JUDGMENT ENTRY REGARDING
JOINT DECLARATION OF PATERNITY
[R.C. 2105.26]

Upon the appearance of the Joint Declarants, and after hearing this matter, the Court makes the following findings and orders:

1. There is no person designated as the father on the birth certificate of the adult child;
2. Genetic test results show that the alleged father is the biological father of the adult child;
3. The joint declaration was freely and voluntarily requested; and
4. It is in the best interest of the alleged father and the adult child that this order be issued.

Therefore, the Court accepts the Joint Declaration, with all supporting documentation and testimony, and orders that the birth certificate of _____, be changed to designate _____, as the adult child's father. This order excludes child support, as set forth in R.C. §2105.26.
