## Checklist Minor Guardianship

## Initial Filing Fee

Court Costs: \$229.00

## Requirements

A minor guardianship may be established in our Court when a minor has received \$25,000 or more, usually through inheritance or a personal injury claim.

In rare circumstances, a minor guardianship may be necessary for situations in which a minor needs a legal guardian due to circumstances where the minor's parents are deceased or otherwise unable to care for the child. If you believe you need a minor guardianship for this purpose, it is recommended that you contact Probate Court prior to filing a minor guardianship to determine if this is the appropriate action for your situation.

Our Court will not accept for filing any application for guardianship of a minor where the sole or primary purpose of the proposed guardianship is to establish residency for the minor to enroll in school or for the purposes of transferring physical custody of a minor from a parent to any other person. Custody for these purposes is a matter that must be submitted to and determined by the Juvenile Court or Domestic Relations Court.
