PROVISIONAL ORDER GRANTING PETITION TO ACCEPT TRANSFER OF GUARDIANSHIP
FROM JURISDICTION OUTSIDE THE STATE OF OHIO
[R.C. 2112.31]

This matter is before the Court on the Petition to Accept Guardianship from Jurisdiction Outside the State of Ohio. Upon the facts set forth in the petition and satisfactory evidence the Court finds the following:

1. The Ward is physically present in or is reasonably expected to move permanently to Fairfield County, Ohio, or if the guardianship is of the estate, the Ward has a significant connection to Fairfield County, Ohio under R.C. 2112.21(A)(2).
2. No objections to the transfer of this guardianship have been made and/or no objections have established that the transfer would be contrary to the interests of the Ward.
3. Plans for the care and services for the Ward, and/or adequate arrangements for management of the Ward's property in Fairfield County, Ohio are reasonable and sufficient.

The Guardian is ordered to file authenticated copies of the proceedings from the transferring state accompanied by the Final Order Transferring Jurisdiction to Fairfield County, Ohio, no later than five (5) days before the hearing on the appointment.
